Last September we launched our first ever happy hour. It certainly has transformed our teatime business, and we are very pleased to continue with it into the new year.

Tea times had got a little quiet at the pub, and in order to combat this, we reduced the price of our draught products during the happy hour period. It certainly has attracted many through the doors to enjoy our award-winning beers at bargain prices.

Happy hour should really be called 'happy hours' as the reductions occur between 3pm and 7pm Monday to Thursday. During these hours a pint of real ale is around 60-80p cheaper per pint and lager and cider around 50-60p cheaper. For example John Smiths Cask is £2.25 a pint and Carling Extra Cold £2.75.

During happy hour we also put

some of Harry Hudson's delicious pork pie on the bar – just another reason to pop in for a pint.

Bar Snacks

Towards the end of last year we added a bar snacks menu to our food offering. These are served in the evening and can be taken in the bar area only.

Our bar snacks consist of a number of items taken from our main menu, plus a selection of good old fashioned basket meals. These include Scampi, a 4oz burger and a triple-decker bacon sandwich.

We also serve everyone's favourite – egg and chips – two local free range eggs with hand cut chips. This is a snip at £3.50!

But don't forget that bar snacks are just an addition – we still have our main menu of steaks, pub classics and lots of fishy specials.
